Cell Phone Policy

Our program at Loft Country Children's Camp is designed to give your child a safe place to have fun and enjoy life without the distraction and pressure that technology and social media can bring in.

Unplugging leaves room for real life activities like making new friends, connecting with people, bonding with the animals, and learning new skills.

We've scheduled each day so that your child is always busy with exciting things that build teamwork and confidence.

Which is why we strongly encourage campers **not** to bring a phone with them to camp.

We ask that your child leaves their phone at home. However, if they must bring their phone to camp we ask that they follow the following cell phone rules.

Rule #1 - During the camp day, cell phones must remain out of sight and in silent mode.

Rule #2 - If a camper needs to use their phone at any point in the day they may ask a staff member who will direct them to First Aid to use their phone away from other campers.

Rule #3 - Cell phones will be confiscated and delivered to the office to be returned to the parent at the end of the day, if the camper is unable to keep their phone away during the day.

Rule #4 Loft Country is not responsible for any damage to or theft of a camper's cell phone.
